Terms & Condition

Payment

1. A \$500 deposit is payable upon signing of the Agreement Contract. The balance with additional charges incurred (if any) will be payable upon delivery of final deliverable.

Reservation

2. In the event that more than one client wishes to book wedding services on the same day, preference will go to the first client to pay the deposit. Rescheduled weddings will only be accommodated if the new date does not conflict with another booked wedding.

Guest Cooperation & Access

- 3. The Photographer will be the exclusive provider of photography coverage. Friends and family members are permitted to operate still and/or video cameras on the condition that they do not interfere with or get in the way of our coverage.
- 4. The Photographer will not tolerate verbally or physically abusive behaviour, nor will it share its time or compete with guest photographers for the attention of the subjects. Unchecked guest conduct that interferes with photography may seriously affect the quality of the photographs taken and increase the number of times photos must be re-taken. If the Couple is unable to control the conduct of their guests, resulting in an unacceptable degree of misconduct, or if the conduct of any of their guests damages the equipment of the Photographer, it will result in the early or immediate departure of the Photographer. The Couple understands that in such an event, no refunds will be granted.
- 5. It is the Couple's responsibility to secure access to areas for photography. The Photographer will not be responsible for coverage lost due to access restrictions.

Professional Imaging

- 6. The Photographer holds the full discretion in all post production works. This includes opening of individual's eyes, red eye removal, de-ageing, removal of people and/or objects, colour correction, special effects, portrait glamorization etc. It is understood that if a technicality prevents the Photographer from performing requested image manipulation, or if a technicality prevents the final result to meet the Couple's requirement, the Couple will reside with the fact that the Photographer has performed to its best ability with regard to the specific task and that the Photographer has no further responsibility towards said image manipulation.
- 7. Prior to or during the event, the Couple may inform the Photographer of subjects which they would like photographed, but the final content of the images is at the discretion of the Photographer.

Limit of Liability

- 8. The Photographer will not be held liable for any production problems beyond our control, i.e. bad weather, accidents, poor acoustics/lighting, interference from guests, etc.
- 9. In the event that the Photographer cannot perform his duty stated in the contract due to fire or other causality, strike, act of God, illness, or other causes beyond the controls of the parties and the Photographer cannot provide another competent professional, all monies received from the Couple and the Photographer shall be returned to the Couple and the Photographer shall have no further liability with respect to the Agreement Contract.
- 10. In the event this Agreement Contract is not completed through no fault of the Photographer, all deposits paid are non-refundable.

11. The Photographer takes the utmost care with respect to exposure, transportation and processing of photographs; including using professional grade equipment and professional grade backup equipment. However, in the unlikely event of the Couple's photographs being lost, stolen or destroyed for reasons within or beyond the Photographer's control, the latter's liability is limited to the return of all payments received for the event package. The limit of liability shall not exceed the contract price stated herein. The limit of liability for a partial loss of originals shall be a prorated amount of the exposures lost based on the percentage of total number of originals.

Non-guarantee

12. Every possible care will be taken to produce photographs of all important and special events during the wedding; the Photographer cannot place an unconditional guarantee on the above. The Photographer will not be held responsible for any ruined photographs due to guests' (or any other) flashes; or any other ruined photographs due to any other cause in or outside of the Photographer's control.

Amendments

13. This contract has been freely negotiated and shall be recognized as the entirety of the agreement. Only those changes or modifications specifically placed in writing, attached, dated and signed by The Couple and the Photographer at the time of acceptance of this contract shall be recognized as amendments to this contract.

Delivery

- 14. Upon taking possession of finished product, the Couple must inform the Photographer of any technical or other problems with the images within seven (7) days. After seven (7) days, if no notification has been received, the Couple will be deemed to be satisfied with the product.
- 15. The Photographer will maintain backup copies of the images in their archive for a period of twelve (12) months at which time the Couple may request for the files. Couple is to provide their own portable storage drive for the copies of the images.

Copyrights

- 16. The Photographer retains the copyright to the images and the right to use them for advertising, trade, educational materials and/or for any other commercial purposes.
- a. Unless mutually agreed to keep images private, selected images from each session will be showcase online on the Photographer's website for public viewing.

Entire Agreement

17. This agreement contains the entire understanding between the Photographer and the CI. It supersedes all prior and simultaneous agreements between the parties. The only way to change or add to this agreement is to do so in writing, and providing the document is signed by all the relevant parties.
